Labourwatch Site Getting Hit

The battle against forced unionism is going strong in cyberspace.

A couple of years ago, the National Citizens Coalition helped to set up www.labourwatch.com, a website designed to make sure employees and employers had a resource to inform them of their rights when it came to unionization.

The staff running the site say 3,500 people visit labourwatch.com each month. The most frequently visited questions are:

- * How do I decertify a union?
- * Why is the union interested in me?
- * What if I have signed a union card but don't support the union?

Labourwatch president John Mortimer, says a group of workers in Newfoundland used information from the site to decertify a union and management in a Saskatchewan company distributed information to their employees who later rejected an attempt of a union to certify their workplace.
