Labourwatch.com Helps Workers

There's a web site union leaders don't like very much: ww.labourwatch.com

This site, which the National Citizens Coalition helps support, provides important information to workers who want to know their rights when it comes to unions and unionization.

One union complained to the British Columbia Labour Board after an employer referred his employees to labourwatch.com during a unionization drive.

But the BCLRB ruled the information on labourwatch.com is "neutral." It also added that the site is limited "to offering a countervailing view to what information an organizing union may be prepared to give employees."

In other words, labourwatch.com's information isn't biased or anti-union. It's just information unions don't seem to want employees or even their existing union members to see.
