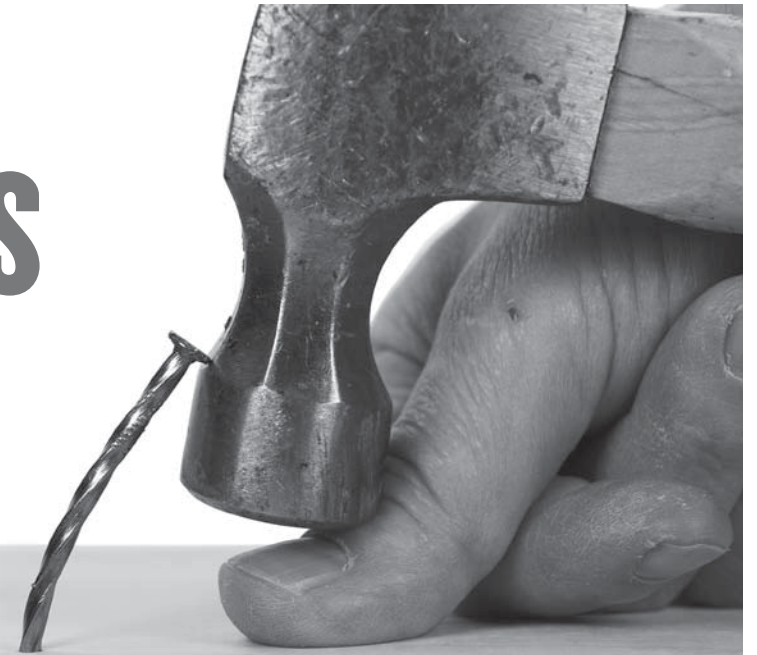


Ontario's UNION LEADERS had a secret plan, too.
