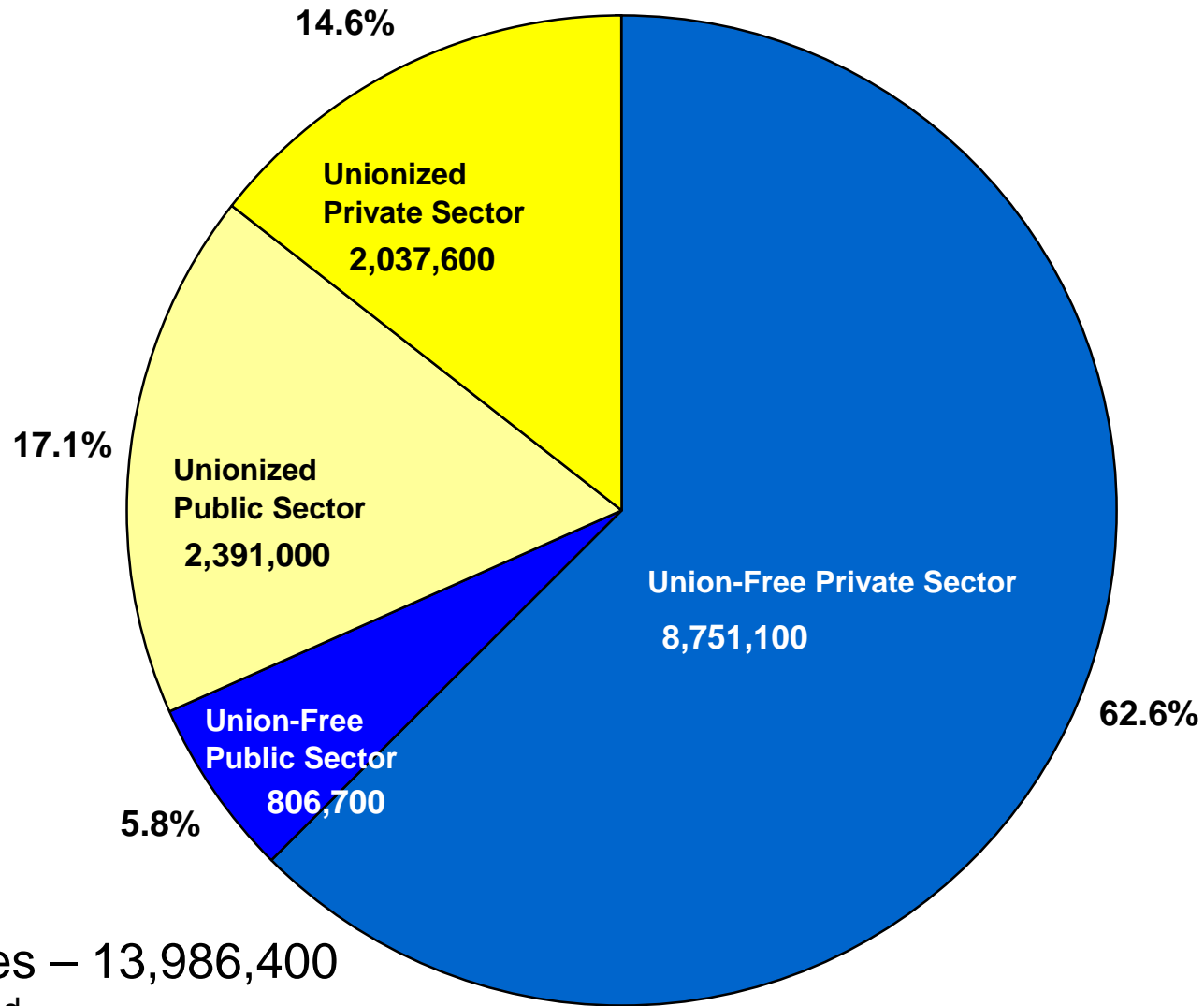
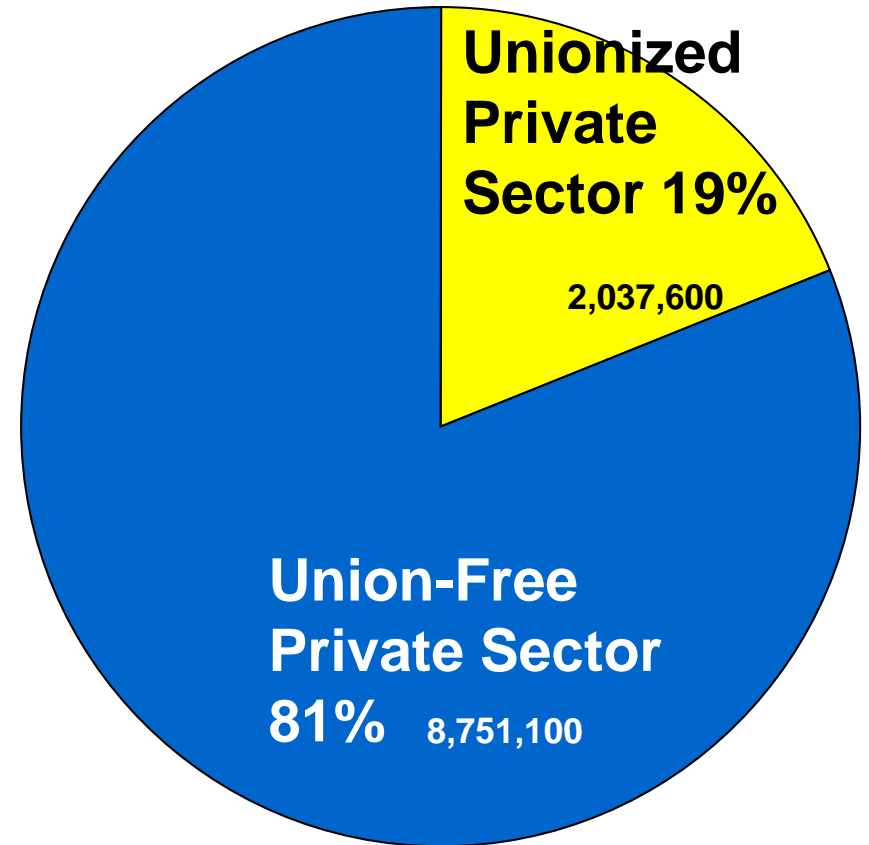
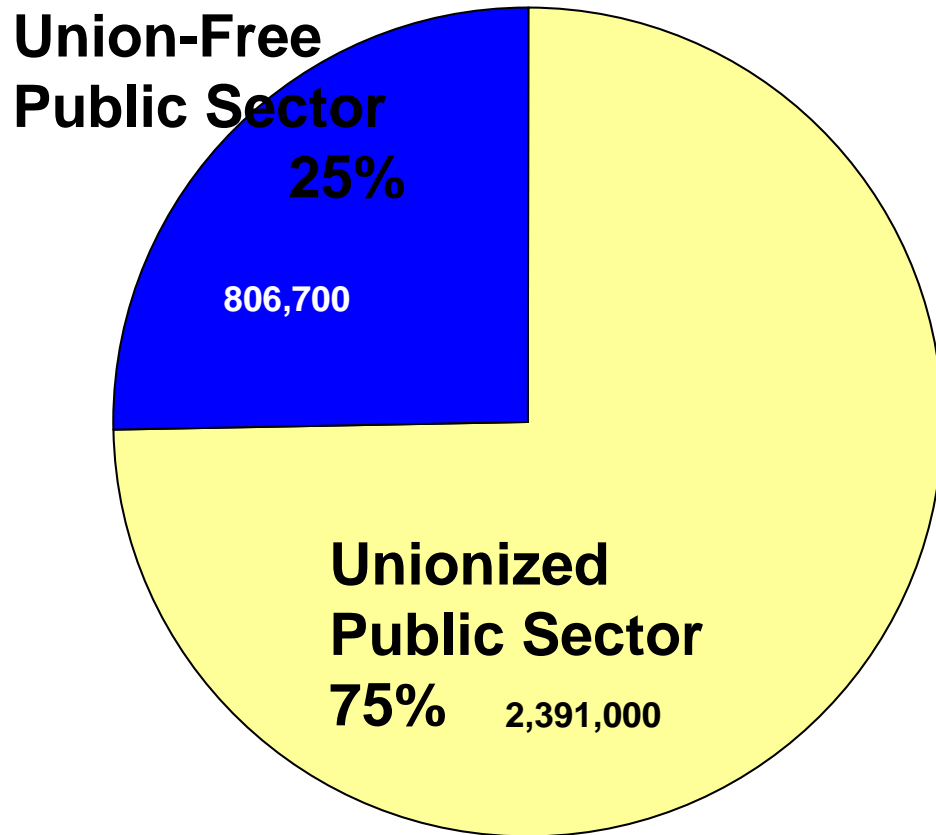


# Unionization and Total Employment in Canada - 2006

## Unionization – Public and Private Breakout - 2006

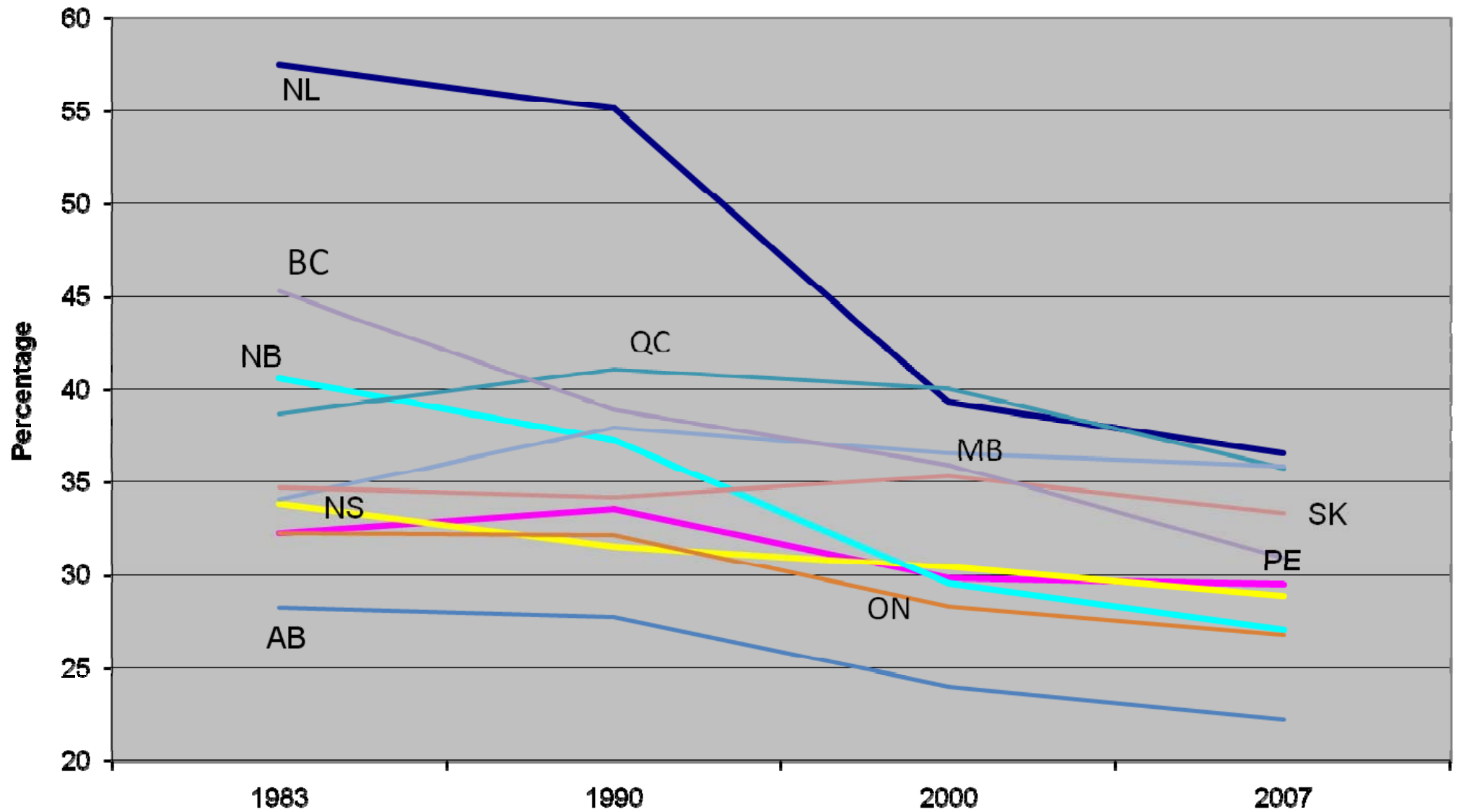

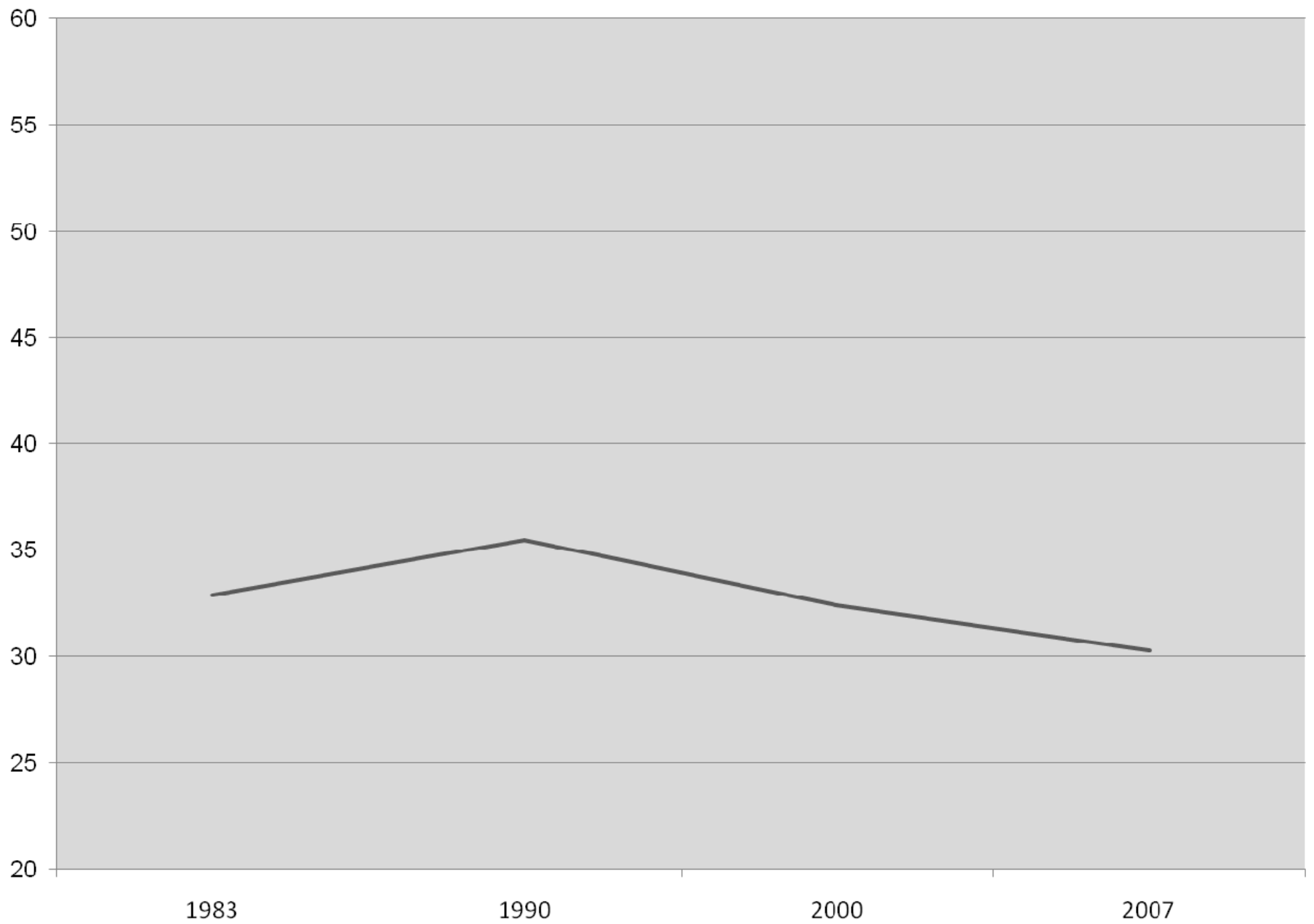

## ***The “Court” of Employee Opinion vs. the Law***

---

***All you say & do will be held for & against you in court of employee opinion***

**Management communications and actions:**

- **Only 18% of private sector Cdns unionized, down from 30% in 1980**
- **Only 7.5% of US private sector unionized, down from 24.6% in 1973**
- **71% of Cdn public sector employees are unionized**
- **40% of US public sector employees are unionized**
- **82% of private sector are union-free in spite of biased labour codes & decisions**
- **81% of union-free Canadians don't want to be unionized**

**NOTE: Employer free speech greater when there is no union activity**
